The global market for these solutions is expected to reach **\$42 billion by 2030**.

Generative AI, driving a new era of productivity

In 2025, generative AI continues its spectacular rise within organizations. According to McKinsey, the percentage of companies using it <u>has increased from 33% in 2023 to 79% today</u>.

In almost every sector, teams now see the opportunity to free up time for higher value-added tasks by delegating some of their repetitive or time-consuming tasks to AI:

- Preparing and following up on projects and meetings;
- Generating ideas to produce faster;
- · Structuring and sharing information;
- Optimizing processes;
- · Collecting and analyzing data...

However, although the enthusiasm is real, the use of AI is often still **in the experimental stage**, even in 2025. According to McKinsey, only 7% of companies have taken the step of deploying AI on a large scale. In addition, according to a new study by Wrike, <u>42% of teams</u> have already used **AI tools that are not officially deployed or approved** by their company, which tends to reinforce silos and make workflows less efficient.



It is also important to remember that generative AI is not intended to replace human collaboration, but to increase its potential. It frees up time, while **leaving teams responsible for decisions**, creativity, adaptability, and social connection.

Although more and more brands are using it in their communications and content, **human intervention is still necessary** to maintain authenticity and prevent online content from looking identical.

Therefore, you must integrate AI into your work practices with discernment, supporting and complementing the value produced by your teams' work.


Visually, key ideas immediately stand out in the generated word cloud, helping you to focus your thinking.


Successfully integrating Al into your collaborative practices requires a **structured and gradual approach**. Here are some actions you can take right now:



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
